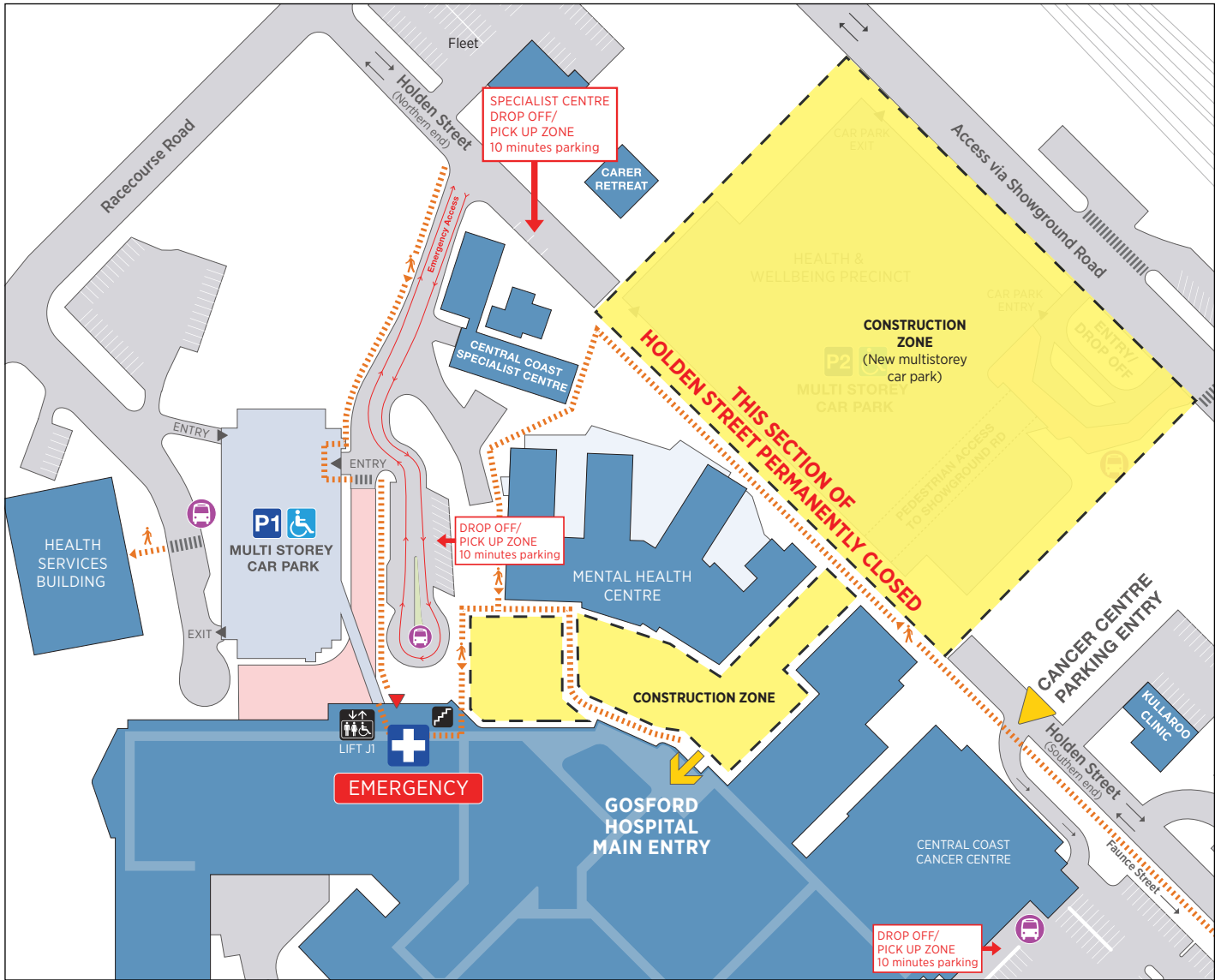


PERMANENT CHANGES TO HOLDEN STREET NO THROUGH ROAD FROM 30 JUNE 2018

From 8am on 30 June 2018 Holden Street will become a no-through road. 



The middle section of Holden Street will be permanently closed to all vehicles with U-turn bays to be constructed at both ends. This is to allow the construction of the new multistorey car park and its pedestrian connection to the hospital.

Vehicle access to the Emergency Department and the drop-off/pick-up zone will only be possible from the Racecourse Road (northern) end of Holden Street.

The permanent access route is via Showground Road.

Access will be retained to Carer Retreat and Specialist Centre from the Racecourse Road (northern) end.

Vehicle access to the Central Coast Cancer Centre and Kullaroo Clinic will be retained from the Faunce Street (southern) end.

This work will also require the removal of some parking spaces.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
