CHANGES TO GOSFORD HOSPITAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT



The Gosford Hospital Emergency Department is moving to Level 3 of the tower from 31 May



From **8am on 31 May 2018** the new Gosford Hospital Emergency Department will open on Level 3 of the tower with changed vehicle and pedestrian access points from Holden Street.

The current driveway access to the existing Emergency Department/ Main Entry drop-off zone will close permanently.

All vehicles will use the new road access to the newly built Emergency Department drop-off zone.

Vehicles will be able to drop-off patients at the new Emergency Department drop-off zone and then enter the multistorey car park or return to Holden Street.

Emergency vehicles will share this road and divert to the new Ambulance Bay.

Pedestrian access points to the Emergency Department will also change. There will be pedestrian Tonstruction and the second se

access to the Emergency Department from Holden Street and from the multistorey car park (to Level 4 then use stairs or lift).

Please note further changes will take place from **8am on 30 June 2018** when Holden Street becomes a no-through road. This is to allow the construction of the new multistorey car park and its pedestrian zones to and from the hospital.

The middle section of Holden Street will be permanently closed to all vehicles and work will be carried out to construct U-turn bays at both ends of the street.

Vehicle access to the Emergency Department will be via the Racecourse Road (northern) end of Holden Street.

Follow road signs and allow extra travel time when possible.
