Submitting an Abstract

- Submissions for Day 2 open on 5 July 2019 and close on 20 August 2019.
- Submit your application <u>here</u>.
- 350 word limit (excluding title, authors and affiliations, headings and references).
- Abstracts require approval from your Manager/Head of Department prior to submission. All successful abstracts will be made available in the public domain following the event.
- All abstracts will be peer reviewed. Accepted abstracts will be published in the Symposium Book of Proceedings.
- All presenters must register and pay the registration fee.
- Individual submissions will be considered for poster presentation if not accepted for their original submission type. Printing of conference posters is to be paid for by the presenter/s.
