

## Behaviour Assessment & Intervention Service (BASIS)

BASIS provides assessment and intervention for people with moderate to very severe & persistent behavioural and psychological symptoms of dementia and mental illness (BPSD/MI).

The service was initiated in response to an increasing need for expert clinical care to people 65 years and over or those with age related conditions with BPSD/ MI.

BASIS is part of Specialist Mental Health Services for Older People (SMHSOP).

BASIS Clinicians are specialists in comprehensive assessment and management of BPSD/MI.

Operating within a person-centred model of care, the service offers:

- Intensive individual assessment with tailored behaviour management plans;
- Education and workshops;
- Joint assessment / consultation with Psychiatrists and Specialist Mental Health Services for Older People;
- Capacity building, support and guidance for clinicians, aged care workers and family carers in managing BPSD;
- Clinical supervision, mentoring and modeling.
