Central Coast Diabetes Services provide information, education and support for people with diabetes, their families and carers.

DIABETES SERVICES STAFF INCLUDE:

 Diabetes Educators, Dietitians, Social Workers and Podiatrists.

Who can access the Diabetes Service

- Adults and children with newly diagnosed
 Type 1 and Type 2 Diabetes, and their carers;
- · Women diagnosed with Gestational Diabetes;
- People diagnosed with impaired glucose tolerance;
- People with diabetes and their families wanting to update their knowledge.

What Services are Provided

- Diabetes Educators, Dietitians and Social Workers provide either group or individual diabetes education and support, depending on individual needs.
- A Paediatric Clinic is held weekly for children and adolescents and their carers. They are seen by a multidisciplinary Diabetes Team including a Paediatric Endocrinologist, Diabetes Educator, Dietitian and Social Worker. HbA1c testing can also be arranged by appointment.
- 3. Weekly Gestational Diabetes Clinics are held in conjunction with the Antenatal Clinic.
- 4. Inpatient consultations.
- Insulin Stabilisation Program in consultation with hospital Endocrinology Staff Specialist and VMO only.
- First Nations people can also access the Diabetes Educator at the Yerin Eleanor Duncan Aboriginal Health Centre at Wyong.
- 7. Ongoing liaison with GPs and other health care providers.
- 8. Education for schools and community groups can be arranged on request.
- Diabetes Services staff are actively involved in promoting community awareness of diabetes activities.

How to Access Diabetes Services

All appointments can be made for:

- Diabetes Educators and Social Workers (individual and group education) by contacting Gosford Diabetes Centre on 4320 3321. For your convenience these appointments are offered at the Community Health Centres.
- Dietitians by contacting the Nutrition Department on 4320 3691.
- Podiatrists by contacting the Podiatry Department on **4320 3240**. (Additional eligibility requirements apply for Podiatry services)
- Paediatric Multidisciplinary Clinics by contacting the Gosford Hospital Specialist Rooms on 4320 5600.
- HbA1c appointments (for children and adolescents only) by contacting the Gosford Diabetes Centre on 4320 3321.
- Gestational Diabetes Service by contacting the Antenatal Clinic, Outpatients Department, Gosford Hospital on 4320 3389.
- First Nations clients wishing to attend the Yerin Eleanor Duncan Aboriginal Health Centre on 4351 1040.

A medical referral is required for all services.
