

Sometimes our teeth can get sick and need to be collected by the tooth fairy.




First, we put some sleepy cream next to your tooth using a little cotton stick.


This can taste a bit minty and feel a bit tingly.



Once the sleepy cream is on your tooth, we check that your tooth goes to sleep.



This might make your cheeks feel a bit big and puffy, like a chipmunk.



When your tooth is asleep, we use tooth huggers to wriggle your tooth out.

It might feel like a bit of pushing.

Once your tooth has come out, you can take it home to be picked up by the tooth fairy.
