







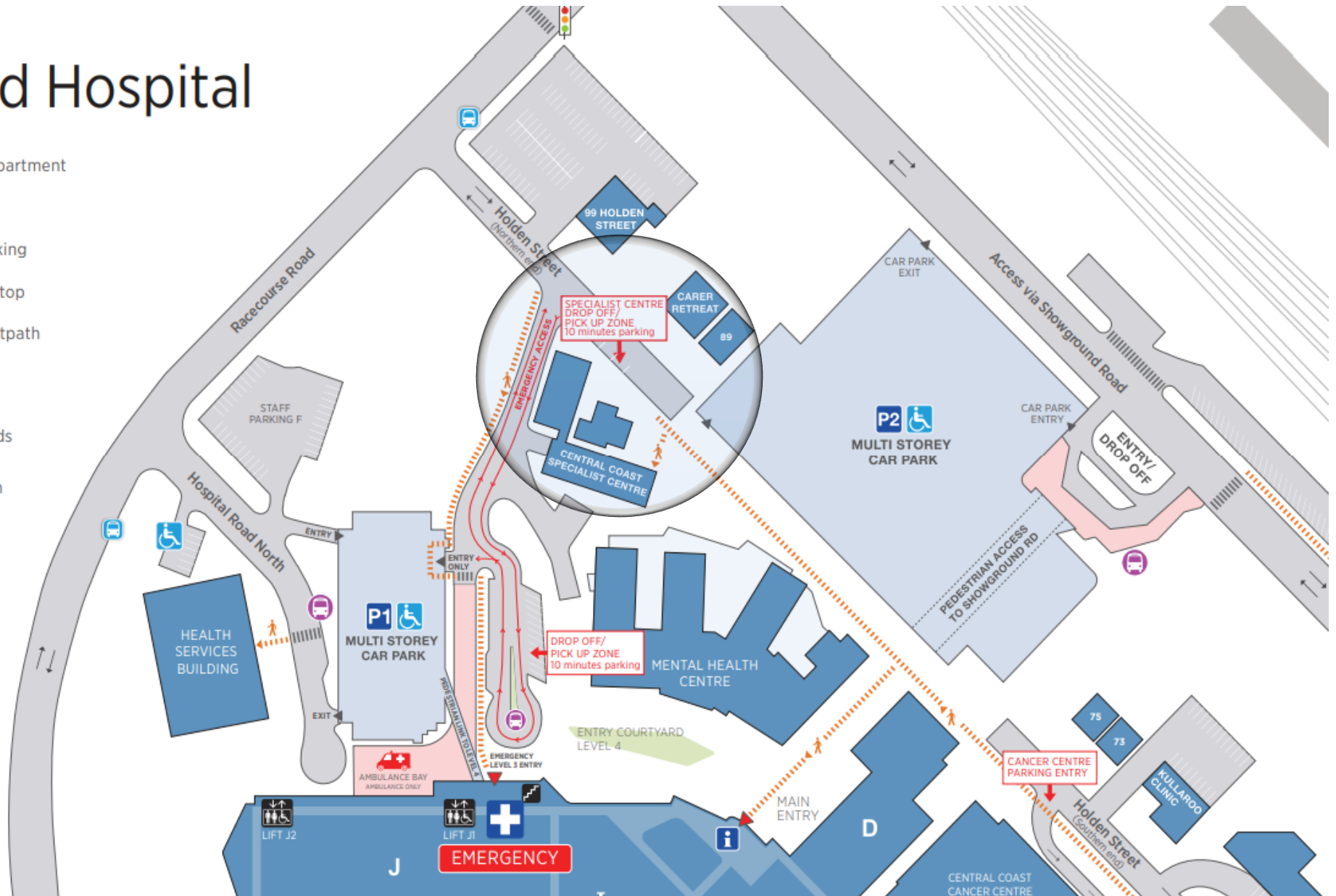

Central Coast Specialist Centre

The Central Coast Specialist Centre has a wheelchair accessible 10 minute drop off/pick up zone in front of the Centre on Holden Street (northern end).

P2 multi-storey car park – Showground Road

The P2 multi-storey car park is located off Showground Road. Public parking is available on the lower levels with lifts available on all levels. Accessible parking spaces are provided on all levels of the multi-storey car park. The P2 car park pay station is located on level 6 adjacent to the lifts.

To access the Central Coast Specialist Centre, take the lift to level 6 and turn right at the paved pedestrian walkway following the signs to the Centre. There are a number of rest locations along the walkway.
