

The following instructions are designed to reduce the potential risk of infection associated with a surgical procedure.

Please shower at home on the **morning** of admission.



Please wash with an antiseptic soap, eg 'Sapoderm'.



Pay attention to:


- ★ Hands, arms, underarms
- ★ Feet, legs
- Anal region, groin
- ★ Abdomen "tummy"

Clean inner navel "belly button" area thoroughly with washer or cotton bud.

If you have an allergy to soap ask a chemist for an alternative.

Dry yourself thoroughly with a freshly laundered towel.

- **DO NOT** apply powders or body creams. Use of a deodorant is acceptable unless you are having shoulder or breast surgery.
- Dress in **FRESHLY** laundered clothing.



N.B Brush teeth with toothpaste. Only shampoo hair but DO NOT wash eyes or inner ears with soap preparation.

The area to be operated on need not be shaved. If required by surgeon, it will be attended to on admission.
